

SOCIAL MEDIA CLAUSE

The following principles apply to use of social media on behalf of the Edgewood Choral Department as well as personal use of social media when referencing the Choraliers as a program, its directors and its members.

This signed document is due at the time of the audition and becomes effective as soon as the 2024-2025 list is posted.

- Students should be aware of the effect their actions may have on their image, as well as the Overtures program's image. The information that students post or publish may be public information for a long time.
- Students should be aware that school administration and directors may observe content and information made available by students through social media. Students should use their best judgment in posting material that is neither inappropriate nor harmful to Edgewood Schools, its students, and the Overtures program.
- Although not an exclusive list, some specific examples of prohibited social media conduct include posting commentary, content, or images that are defamatory, pornographic, proprietary, harassing, libelous, or that can create a hostile environment.
 - Infraction of inappropriate social media postings in reference to the Overtures, other groups we compete against or students within the Overtures program:
 - 1st offense: Student/Parent conference with directors.
 - 2nd offense: Conference with administration and removal from the group.
 - Depending on the severity of the infraction, 1st offense could also result in a conference with the administration and removal from the group.

I understand the above guidelines and expectations concerning social media. I understand that any infraction of these guidelines could result in my/my child's dismissal from the Overtures program.
