

# EDGEWOOD CHORALIER AUDITION PACKET

ALL students who are wishing to audition for Choraliers must attend ONE audition date (May 6 or May 7). Students will sign up for a date by filling out the AUDITION FORM link provided on choir website ([www.edgewoodchoirs.com](http://www.edgewoodchoirs.com)) .

You will be asked to sing the National Anthem and some basic scales. You will also be taught a short dance and perform it in groups of 4-5. Once you are finished, you will be free to leave. All auditions will take place in the choir room after school.

**REQUIRED MATERIALS: MUST be turned in by FRIDAY May 7 or your name **WILL NOT be posted on final 2021-2022 Roster****

1. The Student/Parent Contract and Commitment Agreement (included ONLINE) must be signed digitally via the audition form or you will not be eligible for the group.
2. Social Media Clause (included ONLINE) must be signed digitally via the audition form or you will not be eligible for the group.
  - a. A hard copy of this form will be signed once you are admitted to the group.

## **THE AUDITION:**

Your audition begins as soon as you walk in the choir room. Remember you are making an impression in every aspect of the audition process. Present your best self. Character is a huge part of what we, as a program, represent to the community. Teachers will be emailed a tentative list of students for review to gain feedback based on character, work ethic, ATTENDANCE, grades and discipline.

# SOCIAL MEDIA CLAUSE

The following principles apply to use of social media on behalf of the Edgewood Choral Department as well as personal use of social media when referencing the Choraliers as a program, its directors and its members.

**This signed document is due at the time of audition and becomes effective as soon as the 2021-2022 list is posted.**

- Students should be aware of the effect their actions may have on their image, as well as the Choralier program's image. The information that students post or publish may be public information for a long time.
- Students should be aware that school administration and directors may observe content and information made available by students through social media. Students should use their best judgment in posting material that is neither inappropriate nor harmful to Edgewood Schools, its students, and the Choralier program.
- Although not an exclusive list, some specific examples of prohibited social media conduct include posting commentary, content, or images that are defamatory, pornographic, proprietary, harassing, libelous, or that can create a hostile environment.
  - Infraction of inappropriate social media postings in reference to the Choraliers, other groups we compete against or students within the Choralier program:
    - 1st offense: Student/Parent conference with directors.
    - 2nd offense: Conference with administration and removal from the group.
      - Depending on severity of infraction, 1st offense could also result in conference with administration and removal from group.

I understand the above guidelines and expectations concerning social media. I understand that any infraction of these guidelines could result in my/my child's dismissal from the Choralier program.
